Blue & Gold Opportunity Plan

- Benefits: System-wide tuition and fees combining all sources of scholarship and grant awards you receive
- Eligibility: California resident or have AB 540 status; total family income below \$80,000

Myra Kraft Transitional Year Program

For students who have shown academic promise, tenacity, leadership, and resilience in their life experiences, but have had limitations to their pre-college academic opportunities. In their first year at Brandeis, students in the program take a mixture of Brandeis undergraduate courses and MKTYP-exclusive courses designed at the college level.

- Benefits: Four-year scholarships, \$10,000 \$22,000 (award range per year); robust student services throughout college
- Eligibility: Nomination-based application process;
 plan to pursue doctoral study in STEM

STEM Scholars Program

- Benefits: Supportive mentoring during the crucial first two years; PC laptops for your exclusive use; engage in opportunities, like research, peermentoring, work-related internship with institutional industry partners
- Eligibility: U.S. citizen or lawfully admitted to the U.S. for permanent residence; intend to major in a STEM field; demonstrate financial need

UC San Diego

PATHS

- Benefits: 4-year scholarship up to \$10,000/year; ongoing mentorship; summer research and intern opportunities; interaction with community; philanthropic and STEM industry partners; personal wellness and holistic support
- Eligibility: Be admitted to a STEM major at UCSD; demonstrate commitment to character, culture and community, and interest in the advancement of historically underrepresented populations in the sciences; must commit to living on campus for the first two years of the program

Chancellor's Scholars Program

- Benefits: \$10,000 per year, up to 4 years; summer transition program; guaranteed university housing; faculty and peer mentoring; priority enrollment
- Eligibility: CA resident who apply to UC San Diego & demonstrate financial need are automatically considered for the scholarship

SEED

- Benefits: Housing for summer rising & first year; financial support including scholarships; faculty mentoring
- Eligibility: Interest in a STEM major; leadership and diversity/service involvement

- Benefits: Up to full need; guaranteed housing; priority class enrollment; faculty mentor; financial aid advising & more
- Eligibility: All students who apply to UC Berkeley are automatically considered for the scholarship.

Stephen Effron Scholarship

The Effron Scholarship Program at Hoover High School was established in memory of Helen and Sol Price's nephew, Stephen Effron, who had attended Hoover High School. Scholarship applicants are eligible for either a \$20,000 maximum scholarship to a four-year college or university funded at \$4,000 per year for five years or \$2,000 for a two-year scholarship to a community college, trade or vocational school. Only current Hoover High students are eligible. Please visit the counseling office to obtain an application.
