- 2. Does summer after 9th count in GPA?
- 3. Is Hoover a semester or quarter system?
- 4. Should you report D and F grades?

- 6. How do you apply for an application fee waiver for UC and CSU campuses? How many campuses can you apply to with the fee waiver?

If student does not receive email confirmation of application submission within 2 weeks of submitting, contact the admissions office

• Students get a portal account as soon as they successfully submit their applications. Portals are where all information is sent.

THE CSU APPLICATION

- After submitting your first CSU application the system pre-populates your application for each campus you apply to.
- Grades are self-reported. Send 7th semester transcript only when submitting intent to enroll, even if 12th grade year is not complete
- All undergraduate programs, pre-programs, and undeclared/undecided programs are impacted for the following campuses:
 - Cal Poly San Luis Obispo
 - Fresno State
 - CSU Fullerton
 - Cal State LA
 - CSU Long Beach
 - San Diego State University
 - San José State
- To find out whether a program you're interested in is impacted, use the <u>impaction</u> <u>database</u> to search by campus name and applicant level (freshman or transfer student).
- Picking a major Applying under a campus/major that is not impacted may give you competitive edge
- Recommended to CALL if you have any uncertainty or questions



Four parts of the application

- Personal Information
- Academic History
- Supporting Information
- Program Materials



Don't skip the Program Materials section. The Program Materials quadrant will appear completed if the program(s) you are applying to did not require any additional information from you here. Even if it appears complete, be sure to click and read the Program Materials as campuses put important information about the programs you are applying to in this section.



Colleges Attended

****This section will only appear if you indicated earlier that you have completed one or more courses at a college/university****

- If applicable, you must enter ALL college courses you've ever taken, regardless if they are relevant and even if you transferred them already.

Academic History

High School Coursework

 Complete this section carefully as failure to follow instructions will delay admissions decision and can ultimate impact your admissions decision altogether.

What should you report?

- All high school courses used to satisfy A-G requirements
- Do NOT include non-college prep courses, e.g. Health or P.E.
- Middle school coursework exception: Any math (Algebra or higher) and/or languages other than English courses (LOTE Level 1 or higher) taken in middle school that continued course progression into 9th grade can be entered to receive consideration.

SAT & ACT Results

- Will only be used for English and math placement purposes for admitted students for the 2022-2023 academic year.
- CSU uses the ACT ID and/or College Board ID to match test scores or Cal State Apply application.
- SAT Results
 - May be sent to CSU wide 3594 code or to any one CSU campus
 - Scores will be shared with every campus to which an applicant submits an application
 - · Applicants are highly encouraged to report their College Board ID
- ACT Results
 - May be sent to any one CSU campus
 - · Scores will be shared with every campus to which an applicant submits an application
 - Applicants are highly encouraged to report their ACT ID



MORE REPORTING ADJUSTMENTS

- The CSU will consider course grades of "credit" or "pass" as fulfilling "a-g" requirements for those courses completed during Winter, Spring, Summer or Fall 2020 terms and during Winter, Spring or Summer 2021 terms.
- These temporary changes in admission requirements will also apply to impacted CSU campuses and programs. Campuses and programs designated as impacted may utilize higher "a-g" GPA thresholds for applicants, as well as identify supplemental criteria and their relative weights, in making admission decisions. However, in no case will standardized test scores be utilized in making admissions decisions for applicants during the 2022-2023 academic year.
- The CSU will continue to honor Advanced Placement exams on which scores of 3, 4, or 5 are earned, regardless of the delivery mode of the exam.



Educational Programs & Work Experience

- These responses may be used as supplemental criteria to make Fall 2022 admissions decisions
- Select Yes or No to indicate your involvement in the programs listed
- If you worked during the last 12 months, type in the average # of hours worked per week
- If you were involved in extracurricular activities during the last 12 months, type in the average # of hours per week





EOP



The CSU Educational Opportunity Program (EOP)

- Students who are historically low-income and educationally disadvantaged who need admission assistance and support services to succeed in college.
- The EOP application is built into the Cal State Apply application. Students can submit the Cal State Apply application without the EOP portion complete and come back to it.
- Student can come back to the EOP portion of the application after they submit until January 15th
- Some campuses require students to complete EOP portion earlier (November 30th or December 15th)

Materials students need to apply to EOP

Two Recommendations are required to apply

- One must be from academic counselor/teacher that can comment on student's academic preparedness for university academic work
- 2 The other can be from an individual who can comment about student's potential to succeed in college.
 - Recommenders cannot be self or a family member.
 - Must include their names and email addresses on the application

THE CSU APPLICATION – SDSU

- Local area priority
- College Avenue Compact guaranteed admissions applies to ALL eligible students who have attended Hoover High School consecutively through 9th-12th grades.
- Weber Honors College Separate application and needs to be completed before admissions decisions, **due in January**
 - Opportunity to do undergraduate research 0
- SDSU scholarships close Feb and May (before admissions decisions) so apply early!
