


CLIMATE CHANGE 101: ATMOSPHERIC GASES



Atmosphere is made up of gases. This is natural.

The gases in the atmosphere trap the sun's heat.




CO2 LEVELS FROM MAUNA, LOA

To create electricity or power a vehicle we must burn fossil fuels.


Burning fossil fuels puts more CO₂ into the atmosphere.

Remember more CO₂ into the atmosphere means a <u>warmer</u> Earth.


CITY HEIGHTS, CA



RICHMOND, CA




