If student does not receive email confirmation of application submission within 2 weeks of submitting, contact the admissions office

- Students get a portal account as soon as they successfully submit their applications. Portals are where all information is sent.

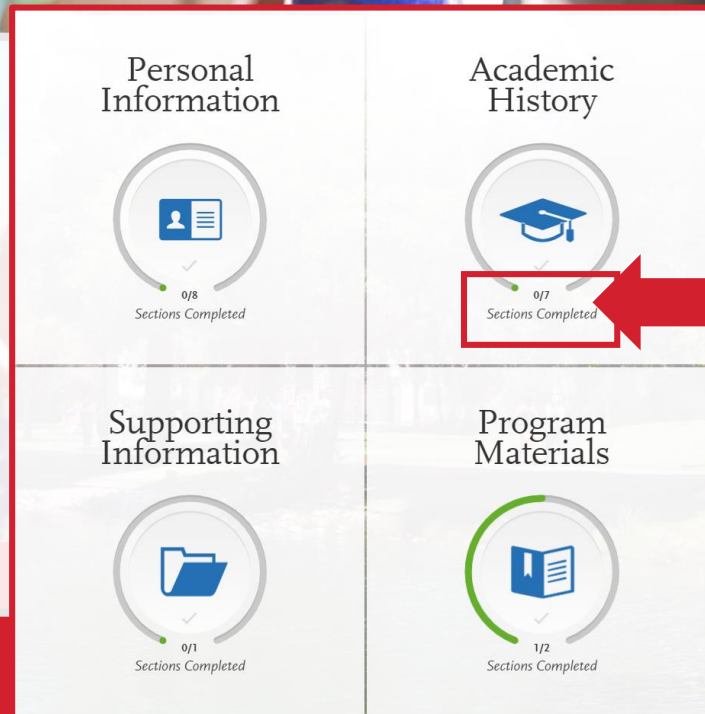


THE CSU APPLICATION

- CSU pre-populates your application for each campus you apply to.
- Picking a major – [check which majors are impacted](#) at the campuses you are applying to
 - Applying under a campus/major that is not impacted may give you competitive edge
- Grades are self-reported. Send 7th semester transcript *only* when submitting intent to enroll, even if 12th grade year is not complete
- Select that you plan to live “on campus”
- **Recommended to CALL if you have *any* uncertainty or questions**

Four parts of the application

- Personal Information
- Academic History
- Supporting Information
- Program Materials



Your progress towards completing all required information in this quadrant

***Don't skip the Program Materials section.** The Program Materials quadrant will appear completed if the program(s) you are applying to did not require any additional information from you here. **Even if it appears complete, be sure to click and read the Program Materials** as campuses put important information about the programs you are applying to in this section.*

Colleges Attended

*****This section will only appear if you indicated earlier that you have completed one or more courses at a college/university*****



- If applicable, you must enter ALL college courses you've ever taken, regardless if they are relevant and even if you transferred them already.
- Start by Adding a College of University

High School Coursework

- Complete this section carefully as failure to follow instructions will delay admissions decision and can ultimately impact your admissions decision altogether.



What should you report?

- All high school courses used to satisfy A-G requirements
- Do NOT include non-college prep courses, e.g. Health or P.E.
- **Middle school coursework exception:** Any math (Algebra or higher) and/or languages other than English courses (LOTE Level 1 or higher) taken in middle school that continued course progression into 9th grade **can** be entered to receive consideration.

Validation

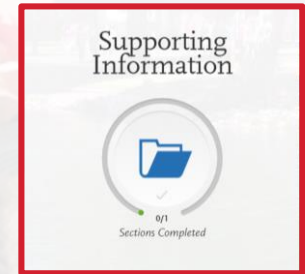
Only available for CA schools with UC CMP data (<https://hs-articulation.ucop.edu/agcourselist>).

CSU Validation applies to: Math, Language Other than English (LOTE) and Chemistry

- Math – C or better in the second semester of Geometry will validate the first semester, C or better in the first semester of Algebra II validates both semesters of Algebra I, Statistics will validate Algebra I and Algebra II, but will not validate Geometry, Advanced math validates the entire sequence.
- LOTE - C or better in a semester of a higher-level course validates a lower-level course
- Chemistry - C or better in the second semester of Chemistry validates the first semester

The CSU Educational Opportunity Program (EOP)

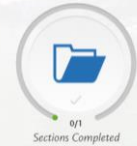
- Students who are historically low-income and educationally disadvantaged who need admission assistance and support services to succeed in college.
- The EOP application is built into the Cal State Apply application. Students can submit the Cal State Apply application without the EOP portion complete and come back to it.
- Student can come back to the EOP portion of the application after they submit until **January 15th**
- Some campuses require students to complete EOP portion earlier (November 30th or December 15th)

The EOP portion has a separate deadline that can vary by campus. Deadlines are found here: <https://www2.calstate.edu/attend/student-services/eop/Pages/eop-campus-status.aspx>

Educational Programs & Work Experience

- These responses may be used as supplemental criteria to make admissions decisions
- Select Yes or No to indicate your involvement in the programs listed
- If you worked during the last 12 months, type in the average # of hours worked per week
- If you were involved in extracurricular activities during the last 12 months, type in the average # of hours per week

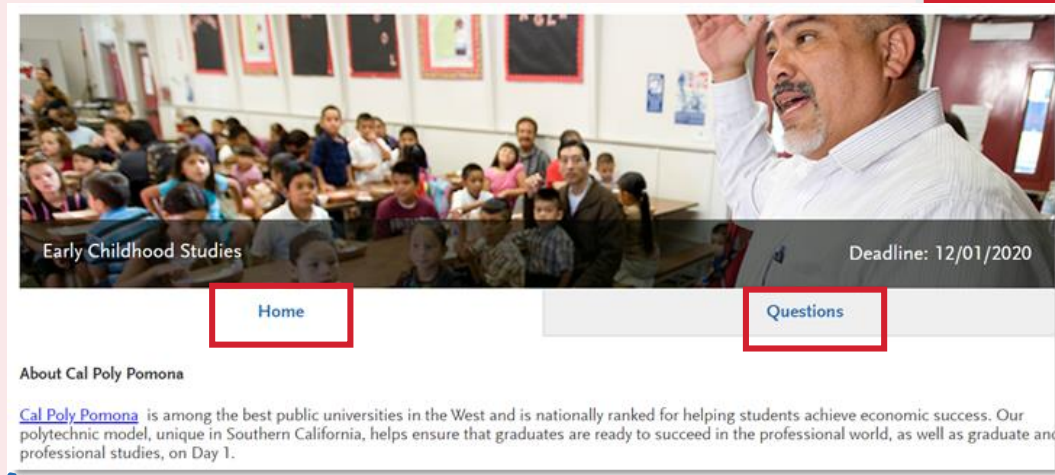
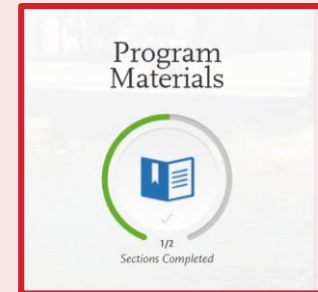

EXAMPLE

THE CSU APPLICATION – SDSU

- Local area priority
- Avenues for Success guaranteed admissions applies to ALL eligible students who have attended Hoover High School consecutively through 9th-12th grades.
- Weber Honors College – Separate application and needs to be completed before admissions decisions, **due in January**
 - Opportunity to do undergraduate research
- [SDSU scholarships](#) close Feb and May (before admissions decisions) so apply early!
