DR. JEANETTE DAVIS

This month Dr. Jeanette Davis visited our Living Lab for a week. Dr. Davis studies microbiology and is also an acclaimed children's book author! During the week, she spent time with our 7th graders educating them on intertidal ecosystems, and with our afterschool students, teaching about invertebrate adaptations.

We also hosted a community book reading, which over 100 families, students, supporters, and alums attended. Through an interview with our ED, Shara Fisler, we all had the opportunity to learn about Dr. Davis's scientific research and pathway to her career. She fielded many questions from the crowd, including thoughtful questions from our youngest audience members, then inspired us by reading her latest book, Jada's Journey Under the Sea.



Ocean Discovery gave away 50 copies of Dr. Davis' book to all the students at the event, and everyone got the chance to get their books by the author herself. Excitingly we will now be providing her book to all of our Kindergarten students annually.
